Obituary

Bobby Glen Pruitt was born September 22, 1950 in Simsboro, Louisiana. He was the second of nine children born to Robert and Carrie Pruitt.

He accepted Christ and was baptized at an early age at Mount Carmel Baptist Church. Bobby graduated from Douglass High School in 1968. After graduation, he entered into the United States Army where he served three years in the Vietnam War and received an honorable discharge. After his service in the Army, he went on to earn a certification in refrigeration from Rose State College. He was previously employed by the FAA Center and Tinker Air Force Base. At the time of his passing, he was employed at ATC Drivertrain Inc., where he worked for 12 years.

Bobby was extremely fond of his children. As his illness progressed, he never lost hope of returning home and being a productive father to his children. He was never at a loss for words.
