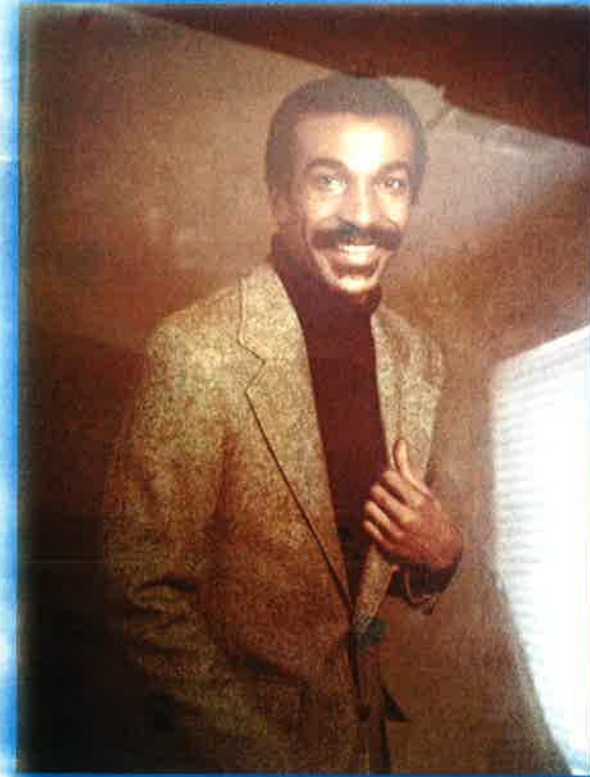


I'm Free
