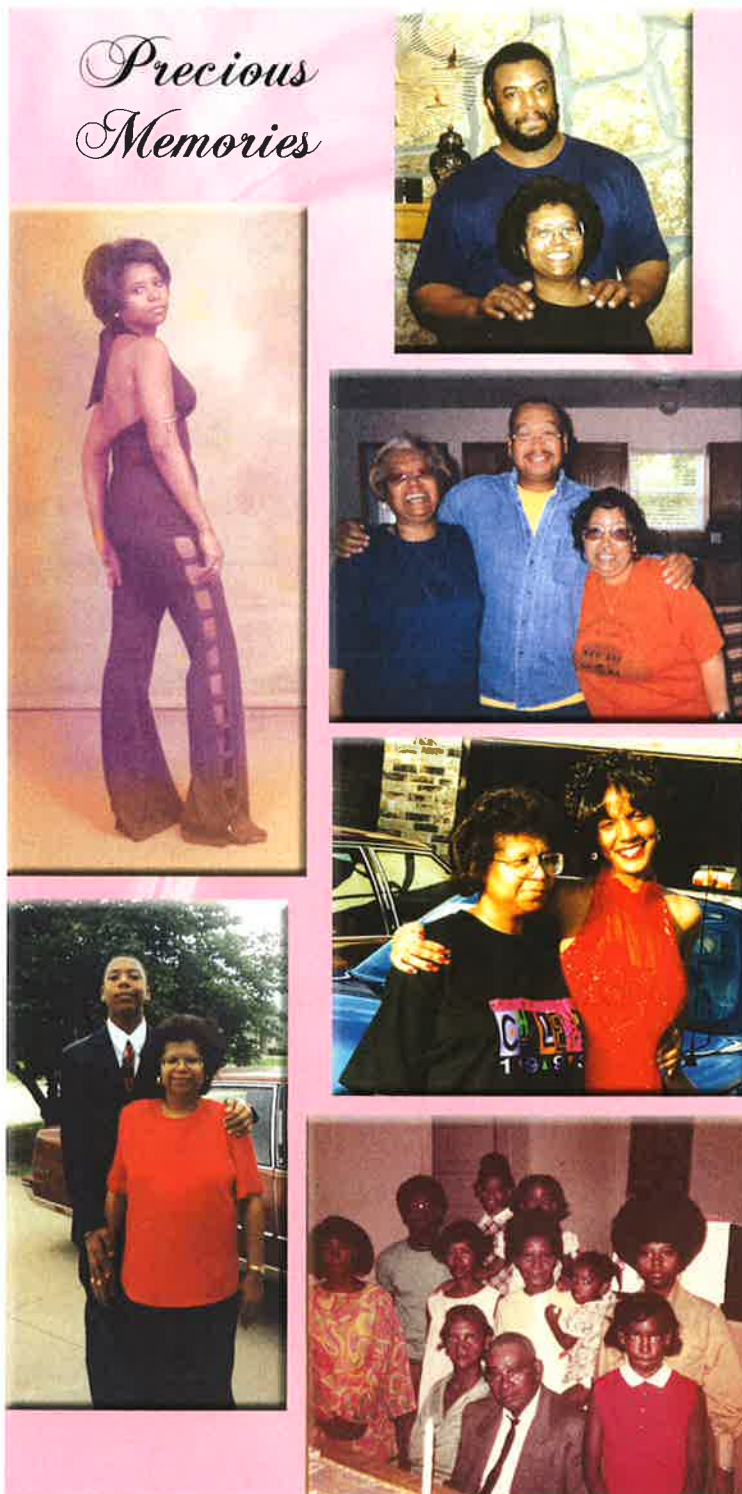




We knew this day would come
