## Obituary

Imogene "Jean" DuBose Knight was born on February 9, 1940 to Nelson and Laurenzia W. DuBose in Boley, Oklahoma.

At the age of three, Jean moved with her parents to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Jean attended Inman Page Elementary School and Moon Junior High School. While attending Moon, Jean was on the State Honor Roll and a member of the National Honor Society. She graduated from Douglass Senior High School in 1958. While attending Douglass, Jean was Chaplain of her Class; a member of the Future Business Leaders of America; a member of the Chorus; and she participated in various school organizations, including the Band Drill Team. Jean was on the State Honor Roll and a member of the National Honor Society. Jean attended Oklahoma State University majoring in Secretarial Administration, and received a Certificate of Training from Draughon School of Business.

Jean joined Tabernacle Baptist Church in 1945 at the age of five, and was baptized by Dr. E. W. Perry. Her church activities included: Starlight Band, Sunday School, Bible School, Baptist Training Union, a member of the Junior Usher Board, and a member of the Junior Choir under the direction of Mrs. Victoria Perry. Jean was a Charter Member of the Tabernacle Concord Choir. She served as President of the Young Matrons Missionary Group. She was a member of the Von Rels Social and Charitable Club, where she served as President and Secretary. Jean was a member of Young and the Adult Ushers where she formerly served as Secretary and Treasurer. The name was changed to The Adult Ushers in 1997. She was a Charter Member of Mable Smith Mission Circle No. 4 and served as Sunshine Chairperson.

Jean was an active member of the Concord Choir. She was a teacher of the Sunday School Elementary Department and Bible School. Jean was actively involved with her Douglass High School Class, where she formerly served as Secretary. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star; a member of the Urban League of Greater Oklahoma City, Inc.; and an active member of Eta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Tau Chapter, Business and Professional Sorority and held several offices.

Jean received Golden Member Medallion and Award for 50 Years of Dedicated Christian Service to Tabernacle Baptist Church and the Community of Oklahoma City on November 25, 1995.

Jean's employment history was with the Oklahoma State Capitol in the Department of Public Welfare; Tinker Air Force Base, Oklahoma City, OK in the Department of Defense; and

Training Technician at Federal Aviation Administration Aeronautical Center in Department of Transportation.

A Certificate of Recognition from U. S. Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration was presented to Jean for having completed 30 years of Federal Service in acknowledgment of duty faithfully performed on April 11, 1992. She received a Gold Medallion from Federal Aviation Administration Academy in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and a Gold Pendant from U.S. Department of Transportation. A plaque from FAA Academy Superintendent was presented to Jean for setting a new standard of Excellence and Dedication in Developing the Proof-of-Concept Course for the Initial En Route Controller Training Program on July 14, 1992.

Jean met Jordan in the summer of 1957. They dated for four years and one year later they became engaged. On Sunday, August 12, 1962 at 4:00 p.m., at Tabernacle Baptist Church, they were married by Dr. Earl Jennings Perry, Sr. On August 12, 2019, they celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary. Jordan and Jean were blessed with two sons, four grandchildren, and one great-grandson. Jean enjoyed reading, listening to music, and spending time with her family, friends, and grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by both parents, Nelson and Laurenzia W. DuBose; sister, Loraine; and one son, Jordan IV. On Saturday, October 5, 2019, she departed this earth.
