Obituary

Ola Lee Chism-Crittenden was born to the late Vera and Frank Crittenden, Sr., in Detroit, Texas. Also preceding her in death are her brothers, Robert, Frank Jr., Dean Crittenden and her sisters, Davella (Jackie) Jones, and Joy M. Hill.

Ola moved with her family to Spencer, Oklahoma at an early age. She graduated from Dunjee Senior High School and attended Langston University for several years before moving to San Diego, California where she graduated from San Diego Business College.
