Kebe married Rose Bigsby in 1958 and to this union, five children were born. He later married Kathy Newman in 1977. In July of 1983, he married Velma Williams, and their love produced two children.

Kebe's was a hard worker, throughout his life he was employed at the Oklahoma State Dept of Health, City of Del City, Rainbo Baking Company, Corken Pump Company, and OEF. Throughout his employment history he retired twice.

Love put many passions in Kebe: passions for being a great father, provider, dancer, sharp dresser and a love for motorcycles. Kebe was flashy in his red suits, always clean from head to toe every time he stepped on the scene! Kebe had a very outgoing personality. He had a special gift of connecting with others. He often referred to himself as a "Bad Motoscooter". Throughout Oklahoma City Kebe was known as "Bad Boy" in the motorcycle community where he also earned many trophies. He was a proud member of the Blue Flames Motorcycle Club and the founder of Big Money Motorcycle Club.

Kebe put on one of his clean suits and went home to dance with the angels on December 24, 2019. He will be truly missed by all those that knew him.

Kebe was preceded in death by his parents and eleven siblings.
