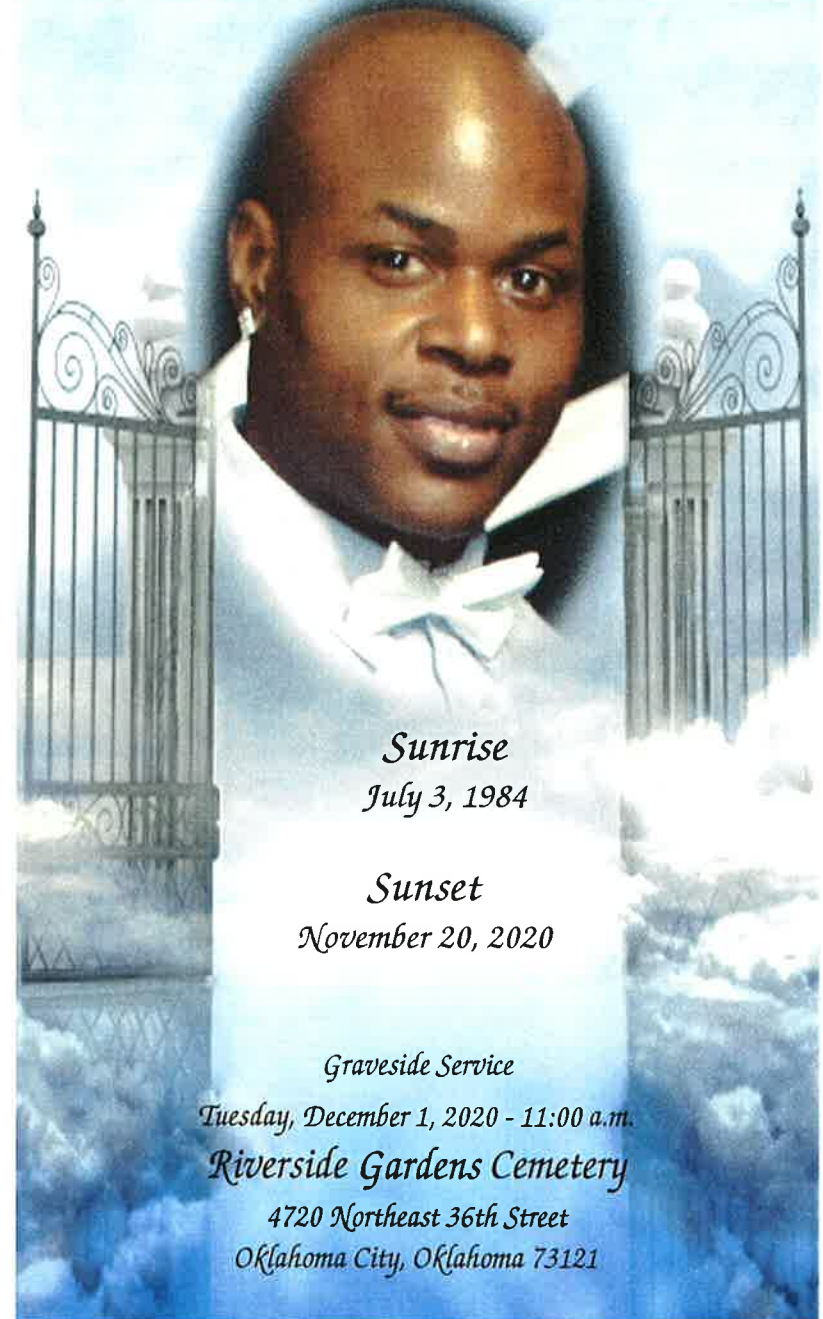

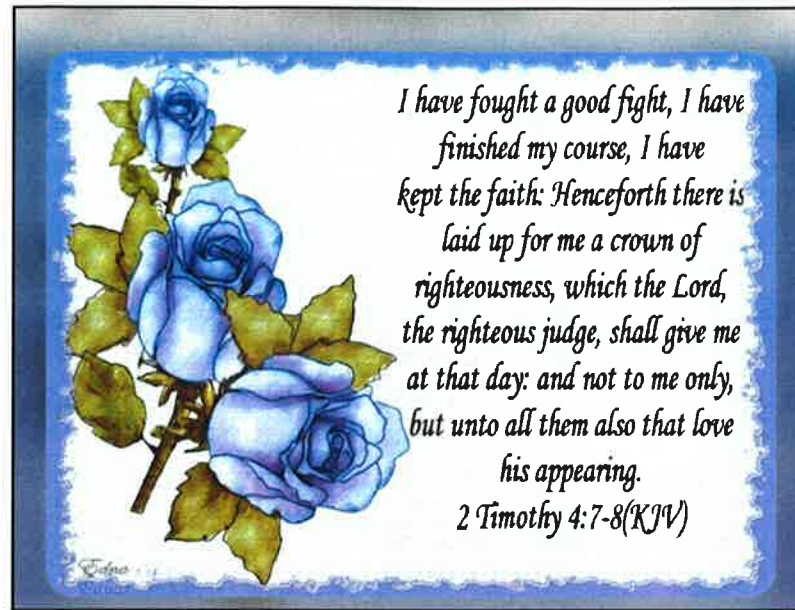
Greg was a twin and third child of five born to Notie A. Wilson and Gregory P. Tucker Sr.
