I could not stay another day, to laugh, to love, to work or play. Tasks left undone must stay that way, I've found now peace at the end of the day.


If my parting has left a void, then fill it with remembered joys. A friendship shared, a laugh, a kiss; Oh yes, these things, I too will miss.
