Liz graduated from Central High School. Being gifted in clerical skills, she landed a job with the City of Oklahoma City not long after graduation. Liz supervised the JTPA program and eventually retired from the City's employment after 30 years of devoted service.

Elizabeth was married to Mr. Jimmy Huff For 9 years. Tamara Dawn Huff joined this union in 1977. She rededicated her life to Jesus Christ in her thirties and served with Pastor Jesse Jackson until moving to Edmond. Being born to a pastor and raised in the church, she loved working in the Ministry and giving of herself to God's people and to the less fortunate.
