Obituary

Roy Chester Robinson was the 13th child born to Jessie and Mae Allie Robinson on August 24, 1945 in Idabel, Oklahoma. He entered eternal rest on March 28, 2021.

As a child, Roy attended Slater elementary school, where he began crafting his gift for debate, practical jokes and imagination for limitless possibilities. He completed his education by graduating from Booker T. Washington High School, then marrying (Hattie Jones) and having two children (Roy F. & Tonya) prior to enlisting into the Army.

After serving his country and being honorably discharged, Roy re-married (Sandra Butler) and raised three children (Anthony, Ricky & Catrina) while setting his sights on trailblazing a pathway that many friends and family utilize as a model for implementation today. In pursuit of these aspirations, he moved to Oklahoma City where he began working at Tinker Air Force Base as a Machinist/Operator. During this time in the 1970's, he was able to lay the foundation for his entrepreneurial dreams by simultaneously owning and operating two successful businesses, R&S Quick Shop and a vending machine company. His diligence and work ethic would afford him the opportunity to purchase his first home in Midwest City.
