

# LIFE REFLECTIONS

R.C. Wallace (who later changed his name to Roscoe Cleophus Wallace) was received into this world by his father Larney Bue Wallace and mother Ressie (Anderson) Wallace on April 22, 1932, in the Township of IXL, Oklahoma. He was one of three siblings of which he became the only child to survive their childhood, he also lost his mother by the time he was a preteen. He then went to live with his dear grandmother Lannie Anderson Wallace where he would stay until he left Oklahoma for the deserts of Arizona where he would remain until he was drafted to serve in the U.S. Army for the Korean War in the early 1950's.

After his military service, he returned to Oklahoma City and had a few female relationships, but it was not until the late 1950's that he found the true love of his life Bertha (Looney) Wallace. It was from this relationship and a prior relationship that produced his children: Cinda, Alfreda, Russell, Geneva, Janice, Vivian, Marilyn, Sylvia, and Herbert. He would also go to have over 57 grandchildren and great grandchildren and great-great grandchildren, and numerous sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, and more cousins and dear friends that could be counted at the time of his passing.

Although Roscoe knew the Lord from an early age it was not until he became a member of Tabitha Baptist Church in 1968, under the pastorate of the Reverend J.M. Albritton, where he rededicated his life to God and became a true man of God, his final church home was Unity Christian Center Church under the pastorate of Pastor Emmett "Mickey" Greene. There he served many roles from member of the Board of Directors (Presiding Elder), Senior Deacon, head Usher and Church custodian (a church role he took very seriously).

Roscoe held several jobs in Oklahoma City but retired in 1996 from Bridgestone Tire Company after 25 years of service. He belonged to various organizations including being President of Citywide Ushers, an organization he loved dearly and was a proud dedicated member of the American Legion Post #157. R.C. also volunteered at various organizations across the city, he feed and gave monies to anyone in need, he visited the sick and those in prison and Senior Centers. His hobbies included keeping his home yard immaculately manicured, having morning coffee with his retired military buddies, fishing, traveling, driving his automobile as much as possible, bowling, bike riding, ink pen collecting (of which he had thousands) reading and was an excellent professor level writer, which few people ever knew and of course reading his Bible which sustained him throughout any difficult time in his life.

Roscoe will leave cherished memories to his family and friends and to any stranger that had the good fortune to come across his path. He will not be soon forgotten because of the love and caring nature he has shown to people throughout his life. R.C. has been released from the pain and suffering that he experienced in the last month of his life and is now a part of the heavenly angels watching over all of us.
