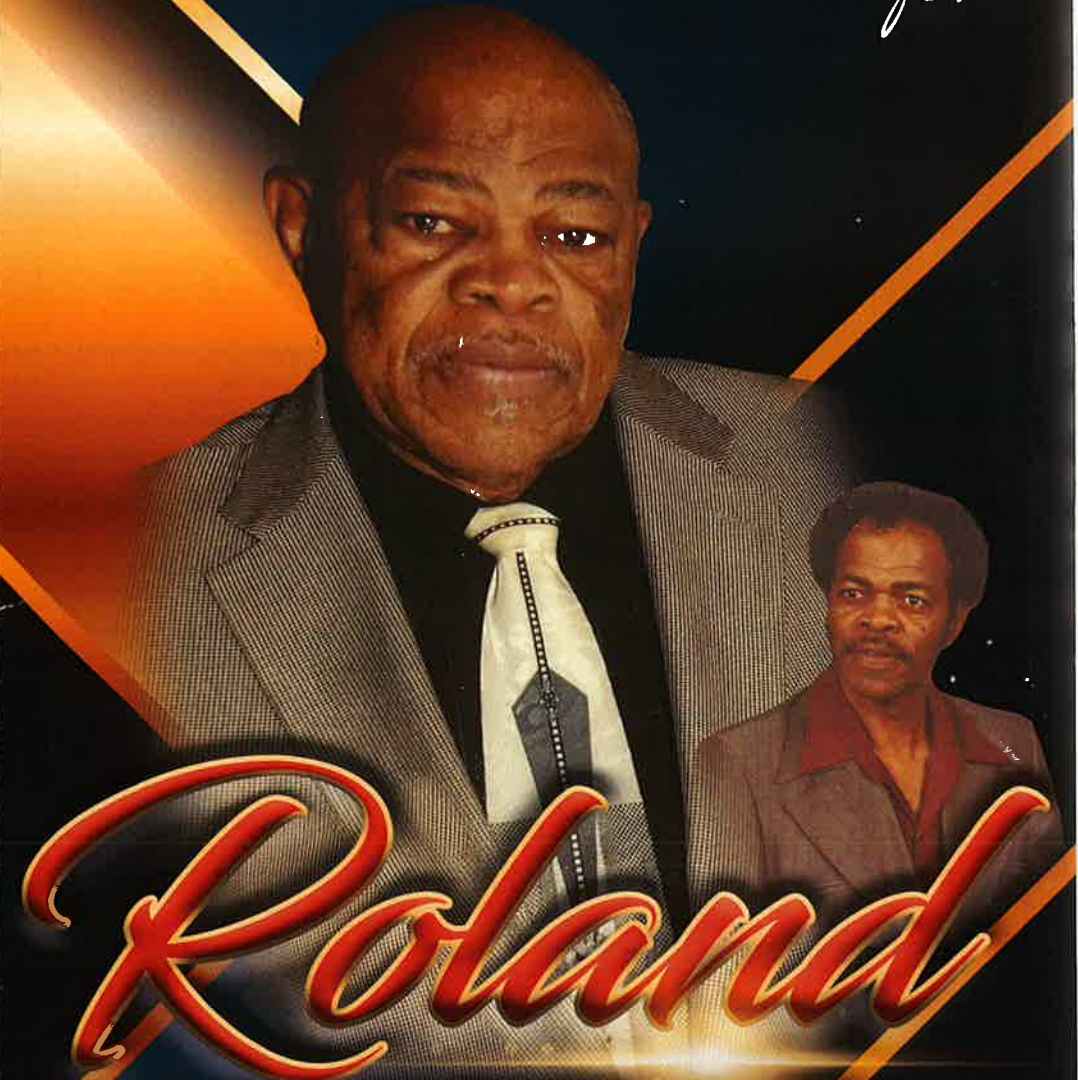

Obituary

On February 14, 1934 a handsome baby boy was born to Rosa Lee and Frank Barnett. As a child, he looked older than he was because of his height and got away with more stuff. Rex would be mischievous and blame Roland, as a result, Roland would get a whipping and then he would put a whipping on Rex.

Roland attended school and graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in Luther, OK in 1951. He excelled in sport and was an outstanding Math student.

Roland was a hard worker from his childhood to adulthood which landed him numerous jobs. He retired from Dayton Tire in Oklahoma City as a supervisor in the Bandbury Department after 27 years.
