# Obituary

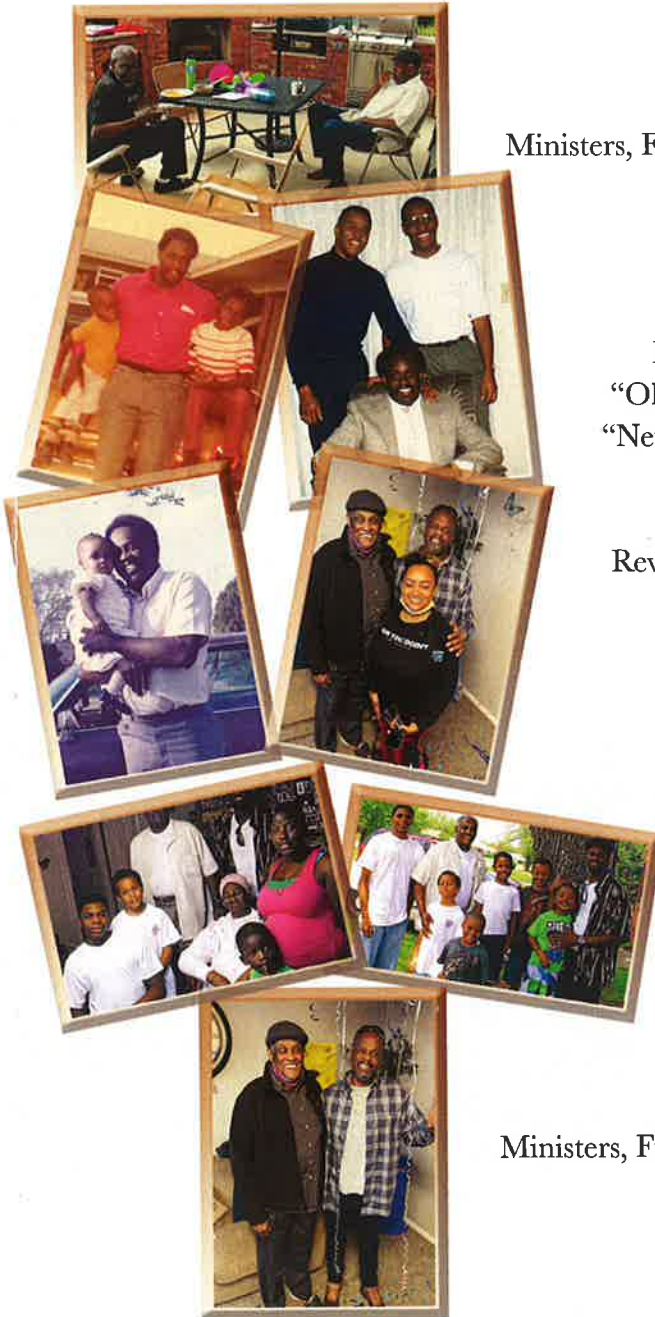
