

Clifford Oliver Looney Jr. was born on December 27, 1946 in Oklahoma City, OK to Clifford and Sadie Looney. He was the oldest of eight children. In baseball he was one of the few great left-handed pitchers. He graduated from Jones High School as an outstanding football player and received a football scholarship to Cameron University. He left Cameron early to join the U.S. Air Force, where he was deployed for two tours in Vietnam. He later graduated from Central State, now the University of Central Oklahoma with a Bachelor of Science in Accounting with a minor in Computer Science as well as a Master of Business Administration. He began his Christian ministry at Bodine Baptist Church and later became a long-time minister of First Baptist Church of Green Pastures. He was a loving father, grandfather, brother, uncle, coach, friend and much more to so many.

He was happily married to his wife, Daisy Looney of 44 years. Their journey began in 1963 when they met and became best friends. After years of friendship Clifford expressed to Daisy that she was the love of his life. On July 1, 1978, Clifford and Daisy were married. Together they had four children.

Clifford retired in 1998 as an internal auditor from Kerr McGee Corporation. He was well-known for his love of bowling, teaching advanced Sunday school, teaching junior achievement classes to public school students, coaching the legendary basketball team "Ponies", soccer team "MWC Stars", and track team "OKC Blazers".
