A step on the road to home.

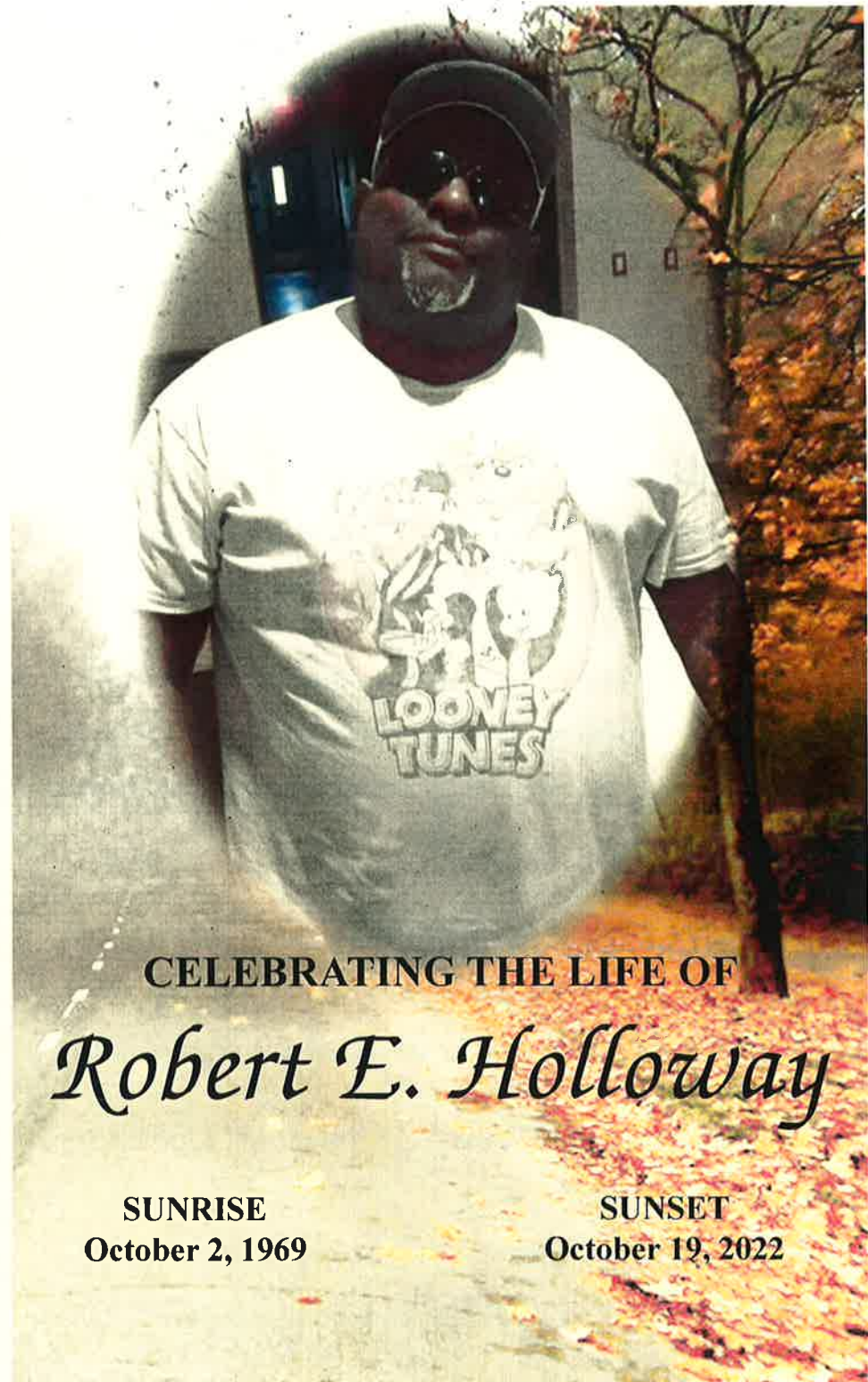
When you are lonely and sick at heart
