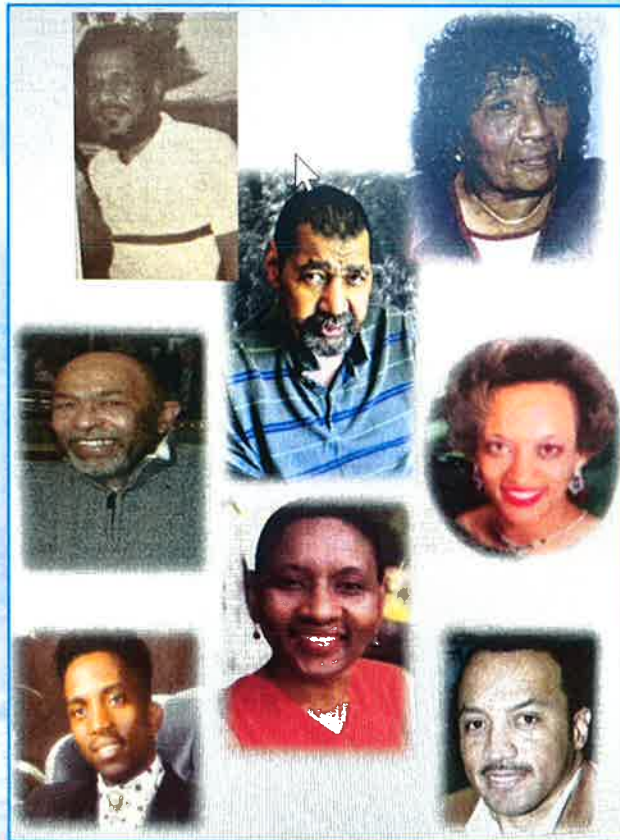


Colossians 2:2 -

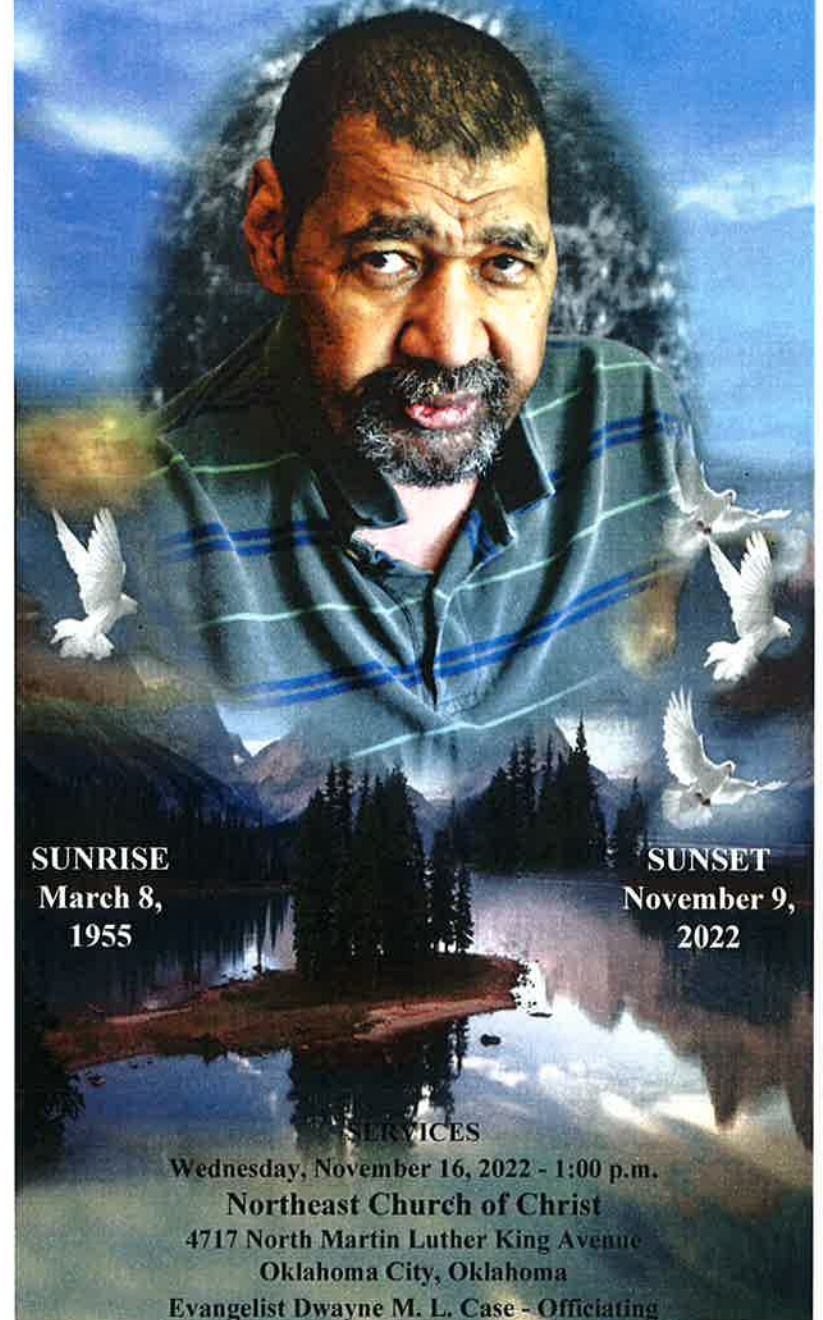
